My name is Wayne T. Taylor and I come from Raupunga. I have been writing in submissions to the Hawkes Bay Regional Council for the last sixteen years. I have the enviable record of never having a successful request. In other words a 100% failure rate unless someone other than me puts in a submission on the matter.

**I have always been consistent with my requests.**

They are as follows. The Mohaka River be returned to Ngati Pahauwera under the Transference of power section 33 of the RMA Act. Gravel extraction on the Mohaka River be properly monitored as the environmental impact is becoming unrepairable. The Salmon and trout hatcheries are being destroyed as well as the native fish and bird habitats.

The Maori Komiti of Council be removed as they have never done anything for Maori in the community

**Recent additions**

**Raupunga** area have no HBRC rates because they never pay it anyway.

**Economic, Cultural and Social well-being.**

The Lowe Walker Corporate Rescue Helicopter Grant to increased from \$2500.00 to \$25000.00 This service provides to the Social-wellbeing of the Hawkes Bay community.

**Sports Hawkes Bay** has its Grant of \$10,000.00 increased to \$100,000.00. The trust is officially known as The Hawkes Bay Regional Sports Trust is the only body that represents the interest of all Hawkes Bay that the Hawkes Bay Regional Council gives grants to. If the figures to remain at \$10,000.00 that the period of this grant be extended to the end of 2020 and be inflation and CPI adjusted each year. The organisation progresses the cultural and social well-being of the Hawkes Bay Community.

**Raupunga Marae** be given an investment grant of \$10000.00 from the Other investment property. Refer to Page Financial Information Part 3 page 9 The Hawkes Bay Opera House was given a big grant and Maori hardly ever use it. I objected to the grant being given because I basically said you would never give a grant to Ngati Pahauwera/Raupunga because we would never use it. This is your chance to prove my judgement wrong.

**A sum of up to \$30,000.00** be set aside from the leasehold endowment land in Napier for an environmental impact report for the coastal marine area of the Mohaka River for the improvement, protection, management for the impact of gravel extraction on the Mohaka River. Refer to Financial information Part3 page 8 number a paragraph 2. 'The expenditure as stated must be incurred for the improvement, protection, management, or use of the napier harbour or the coastal marine area in the region.'
