## MAXIMUM COSTS FOR 2008/2009

- Where individual consultant's fees are in excess of \$2,000 (i.e. grant of \$1,000 or more sought) the applicant must either:

- **ON FARM WORK**

On farm contribution is limited to \$5,000 or 33.3% of the total cost of the project, whichever is less.
