Thanks very much for meeting with me a few weeks ago, apologies for my delayed follow up.

Please find attached a summary of the works planned to support and give confidence to the support we are requesting for the project and programme of works.

Below is a summary of the project stages with dates and milestones at the end of each stage, these are being engaged on as part of the upcoming Long Term Plan.

The affected party approval is also attached for your review and signing to accompany our consent application to HBRC.

Ideally we would like this support to extend to the short term ongoing consenting requirements, to continue the status quo at Te Paerahi for up to 4 years, and Porangahau for up to 6 years.

And then the longer term support for the project to deliver as outlined in the box below within the next 9 years.
