Firstly I would like to commend the CHBDC and the Drummond family for the work done thus far and in the consent process, Having listened to the community regarding the view that treated sewage dispersal to the Makaretu River cannot continue in its present form ,from the present system at Takapau.

That being said a number of concerns I have and would like considered, have led me to submit:

The proximity to two of the three entrances to our village(Charlotte and Nancy streets, from state Highway 2) of the proposed scheme and the limiting factor this may present, in future, to commercial development at these intersections.

The provision for, and inclusion of (in the proposal) vegetation borders and fencing may mitigate access to public (for ecoli and associated risk plus odour) and provide a sight and perhaps odour barrier.

The only provision I see, for such planting is in the red zone on Page 19 of the conceptual plans (april 2021) and involves riparian areas to further protect Makaretu: which I agree with, however, the plantings, I think, should include the area bordering Highway 2 for the whole length of the proposed total scheme, also the whole length of the proposed scheme on the Makaretu river boundary..

The Makaretu River riparion planting (which I see as an extra filter for Makaretu could include native timber plantings with a veiw to harvest for financial return to upgrade in future, (local advice around varietals would aid success with this.)

The Highway 2 boundary (plus boundary of the scheme Between Highway2 and Makaretu on the western side) plantings to screen public and odour would also prevent the prevailing winds of the area causing transpiration and evaporation and could have the effect of maximising the retention of the water in a beneficial way to the landowners.

So my submission calls on council to seek a commitment to "ringfence' and provide plant material suitable, and plant the areas around the proposed scheme at the first opportunity, for the reasons I have put forward.

A couple of things I have noted in the consent that are aside from my concerns, outlined above, are around ownership:

1 the ownership of the land through the middle of the proposed storage on Burnside Rd, This seems to be (or have been)public road access to Makaretu.

2 the ownership of the Dalby property (on the consent sometimes misspelt as Darby). It seems that a person other than the owner has signed the consent paperwork (Consent Application(5+6)AppendixC+D Landowner Approvals/Records of Title)

I seek the A solid commitment to a riparian buffer to be included, created, fenced, planted, mulched and maintained between Makaretu along the boundary with the entire scheme

The same commitment to a planted area (public screen and odour buffer) between the Highway 2 and well past Nancy St intersection in the west to Burnside Rd/ Charlotte St intersection in the east Provision for the planting and fencing of Dalby property boundary with the proposed scheme between Makaretu and Highway2
