



MANAGING ASBESTOS



What is it?


Asbestos is a naturally occurring mineral made up of many small fibres. These fibres are very strong and are highly resistant to heat, fire, chemicals and wear. It's a proven human carcinogen, and all forms of it can cause cancer. The main way people are exposed to asbestos is by breathing in air that contains asbestos fibres.

Asbestos exposure is New Zealand's number one workplace killer. If you don't take the right precautions to protect yourself, you're risking your life and your livelihood.

It won't be obvious that you have asbestos

in your house/building – which is why we highly recommend getting your house/building tested by a professional contractor. To reduce the financial burden of this on residents, Council has created a process and is providing free asbestos testing for Cyclone Gabrielle stickered properties. The process

We recommend using a professional contractor to deconstruct your house/building. We've created a process to support safe handling of asbestos.

My house/building needs to be checked for asbestos before I start deconstructing/demolishing it.

Contact Hawke's Bay Regional Council for asbestos testing and guidance on **0800 108 838**. Through the **Silt and Debris Recovery Taskforce** the job will be sent onto a contractor to undertake a visit, sampling and provide guidance.

Costs

Asbestos testing and guidance from a contractor is funded. The homeowner will need to pay for any associated removal costs (this will vary depending on amount of asbestos found).

Prepare building for disposal, making sure items with asbestos are wrapped correctly.

Contact pre-approved company to collect and take items to a pre-approved disposal site.

Sign the contractor checklist – contractors will bring this with them.

Pay invoice - removal is at the homeowner's expense.
