Your request to immobilise is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. Vessel mooring lines/anchor and arrangements are to be properly tended at all times.
2. Shore moorings are to be used if required by the Duty Pilot.
3. Any mooring failure (vessel or shore) is to be reported immediately to the Duty Pilot phone (06) 833 4471 and Harbour Control on VHF Ch. 12.
4. Approval is required to extend the immobilisation period beyond the times specified above.
5. The Master must report to Harbour Control on VHF Ch. 12 once the vessel engine is immobilised and on completion of the immobilisation. A listening watch must be maintained throughout the immobilisation.
6. Gangways must be lifted before the engine is tested.
7. Vessels are not to test engines during cargo operations or whilst any cargo related equipment is connected to, or positioned on or above the vessel. This includes cranes and cargo hoses.
8. Testing must be kept to a minimum to reduce risk of damage to port infrastructure. Vessels on adjacent berths must be informed prior to testing engines.
9. Masters are reminded of their duty to ensure all machinery is operational prior to departure.

I/We agree to the above conditions and will ensure that they are complied with for the duration of the permit. I acknowledge that the Company I represent and the workers and contractors we use will have documented safe systems of work in place, use equipment that is certified (when required) and is fit for purpose as per worksafe/Maritime NZ guidelines, are competent in the work being undertaken, hold all required permits for regulatory compliance and will always work in a safe manner. I also acknowledge that if lodging this request electronically, the Hawke's Bay Regional Council will accept this communication as containing my signature for the purposes of Part 4 Electronic transactions of the Contract and Commercial Law Act 2017.
