

## Appendix 2: Project Approach: OWB Plan Change

Table 26: Project approach: OWB Plan Change (adopted by RPC in 2017)

<b>Part 1</b>	Comprise an initial list of named water bodies from Draft Change 5 and those water bodies of significance to Tāngata whenua as listed in deeds of settlements, statutory acknowledgements, Treaty settlement legislation and three court cases.
<b>Part 2</b>	Carry out a high level review of all water bodies on the 'initial list', presenting the findings in a table format featuring the following value headings for each water body: importance to Tāngata whenua, water quality, recreation, ecology, natural features, landscape and scientific.
<b>Part 3</b>	Report findings of high level review back to RPC. Confirm short list of 'candidate outstanding water bodies' followed by a secondary analysis and consultation with iwi authorities and district councils.
<b>Part 4:</b>	Report findings back to RPC of the secondary analysis on candidate outstanding water bodies, plus comments from consultation with key stakeholders, iwi authorities and district councils. RPC to confirm water bodies which are outstanding in Hawke's Bay for the purposes of the NPSFM.
<b>Part 5:</b>	Draft a plan change accordingly, carry out consultation, and present a draft outstanding water body plan change to RPC for adoption and notification.
