
## Part I (Glossary)

## 1.54 Coastal Hazard Zone 1 (CHZ1)

means an area seaward of the CHZ1 boundary identified on the planning maps which is land assessed as being subject to storm erosion, short-term fluctuations and dune instability <u>and includes rivermouth and stream mouth areas susceptible to both erosion and inundation due to additional hydraulic forcing of river or estuary systems.</u> For the purposes of this Plan, it extends a distance of 200m seaward from its inland boundary.
